PTI Islamabad chapter protests Negroponte visit

Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf Islamabad Chapter staged a protest on Wed 12th September in the vicinity of Pakistan Foreign Office, Islamabad. The protest was originally meant to be held in front of the FO on the arrival of US Dpty Secretary of State Mr John Negroponte, but heavy presence of Federal Capital Police and blockades didn't allow that to happen as planned. John Negroponte held talks at the Foreign Office with Pakistani Foreign Secretary Riaz Mohammad Khan. Imran Khan said that US are talking about fostering democracies in the Muslim world and about 800,000 people have been killed in Iraq in the name of democracy. Protestors chanted anti-Musharaf, Anti-US and Anti-Altaf slogans and held up placards saying: 'Negroponte Go Home', 'War on Terror is War of Terror', 'Stop Meddling in our Affairs', 'Negroponte You are Not Welcome'.
